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WELCOME TO KALININGRAD REGION!

For entering the Kaliningrad region Russian citizens and citizens of CIS must have international or civil passport. For arriving to Kaliningrad by air it's enough to have a civil passport. If you are going to come to Kaliningrad by car you will need a Schengen visa. Citizens of other countries will need Russian visa. It can be issued in Russian Consular Offices in home countries. Citizens of states, entered Schengen agreement, as well as citizens of Great Britain, Switzerland and Japan may get short-term tourism visas (up to 72 hours) with assistance of tourism operators listed below:

To obtain a visa you need to provide the following information to one of the listed above travel agencies not later than 72 hours prior arrival in Kaliningrad region:

1. Scanned copy of the passport
 2. Home/work address and phone numbers
 3. Date of arrival and one of the border crossing point:
 - Bagrationovsk
 - Mamonovo
- Airport Khrabrovo (in case of arrival at the airport, you should have a color photograph 3 X 4 cm)

The travel agency chosen by you will reserve the hotel for you (indispensable condition), will issue the medical insurance and other necessary documents, and also will deliver the representative of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to the border crossing point.

HOW TO GET TO KALININGRAD REGION

By train

At the railway station "Kaliningrad-passenger" there is a railroad connection with such cities as Moscow, Saint-Petersburg, Charkiv, Chelyabinsk, Gdynia (Poland), Adler, Berlin (Germany), Murmansk, Sevastopol, Kyiv. Connection with some of above cities is available during the summer period only.

To cross the territory of the Lithuanian Republic from the Kaliningrad region to other part of the Russian Federation and back, citizens of the Russian Federation should get special document - Railroad facilitated transit document (RFTD).

For obtaining RFTD it is necessary not later than for 28 hours to acquire ticket in any railroad cash-desk in the Russian Federation. RFTD is given out by consular workers of the Lithuanian Republic in the transit trains listed below:

The passenger who does not have a valid facilitated transit document or visa is not allowed on a train.

Time of stay in the Lithuanian Republic on RFTD is no more than 6 hours. RFTD does not allow the intersection of the Republic of Lithuania on the other vehicle (except specified above) and entrance into the other country. RFTD is given out to the Russian citizens only.

By car

Several routs of international importance lead to Kaliningrad. Three of them are through the territory of Poland (border-crossing points: Bagrationovsk-Bezledy, Mamonovo-Gronovo, Mamonovo-Gzhehotki, Gusev-Goldap) and four are on the territory of Lithuania (border-crossing points: Tchernyshevskoe-Kybartai, Sovetsk-panemune, Pogranichnyi-Ramonishkai (bilateral), Morskoe-Nida). The most intensive are points in Tchernyshevskoe and Sovetsk and the calmest one is in Morskoe (Curonian Spit).
